Client results in the Life Transformation Program have been amazing. After one full year, our Women in the Program achieved an 88% success rate of safely transitioning to sobriety, stable employment, and secure housing. During our start-up year of this program, we have developed strategic partnerships with professional service providers in the community who play a key role in the program. From the moment clients enter our doors, we have processes to assist them with mental health screening, primary medical care, counseling, and case management, as well as immediate employment.

Thanks to our partnerships with Life Management Center, Doorways of Northwest Florida, St. Andrews Baptist Hope Center, Maximus, and Wal-Mart, our clients immediately receive health care, mental health counseling, and stable employment. After saving money to move back into society, we work with Doorways to assist clients with security deposits and first month's rent. This one-of-a-kind Program is both an innovative and unique service in our community. We will be implementing the same program at our Men's Facility when it re-opens this summer. We are currently in need of financial assistance to complete the project.
