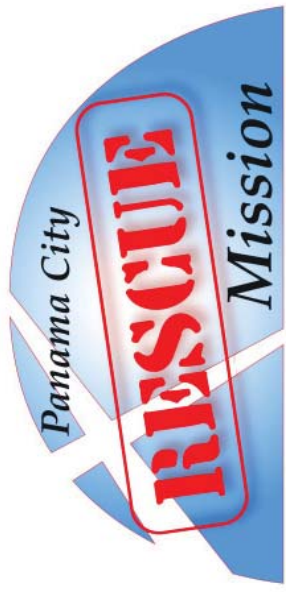

OUR MISSION

To provide an environment where the compassion and love of Jesus Christ heals and equips people to be successful in overcoming life's adversities. We are a faith-based, nonprofit organization dedicated to transforming troubled lives in a loving Christian environment.

OUR GOAL

To provide a continuum of care for homeless and disadvantaged individuals with ongoing assistance in a recovery-oriented environment through transitional housing. We offer shelter, meals, clothing, rehabilitation through extensive biblical studies, chapel services, addiction recovery, education services, vocational training, and job placement assistance.

EMERGENCY SHELTER

Emergency shelter is limited to five days. All clients are required to enter the facility alcohol and drug free. During their stay, they are offered mentoring and pastoral support and invited to enter one of our programs if they need to extend their stay.

FOOD SERVICES

We serve more than 300 meals per day, 365 days a year. Anyone in need is welcome to join us for dinner each evening. The general public receives one hot meal a day and bakery goods, while program participants are provided three meals per day.

ADDICTION RECOVERY PROGRAM

Our recovery program follows the biblical model of community-based discipleship – disciples making disciples – and offers comprehensive support through a variety of long term recovery classes over 12-14 months. Clients receive professional instruction in the field of addictions. In the final phase of the program, clients find employment prior to graduation. An aftercare plan is developed, and the client must start a housing search. We follow up with our clients regularly for the first year beyond graduation and celebrate success rates far higher than most secular, non-faith-based programs.

SUPPORT SERVICES

Our social services department is dedicated to helping clients through case management and networking with more than 250 area agencies to provide on-going support, including housing, counseling, mental health services and much more.

WORK AND TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM

Clients are supervised and trained in real-world work environments in preparation for permanent employment. They receive counseling and must maintain sobriety while in the program. Clients are disciplined through spiritual self-studies throughout the week and church on Sundays.
